1 Introduction

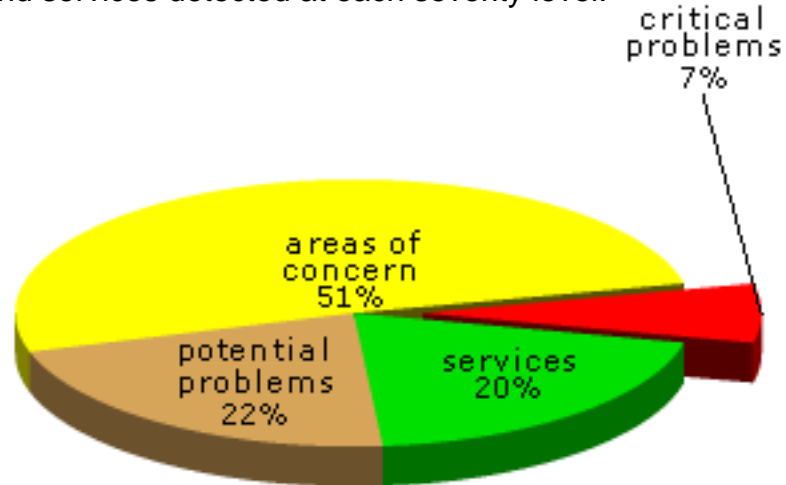
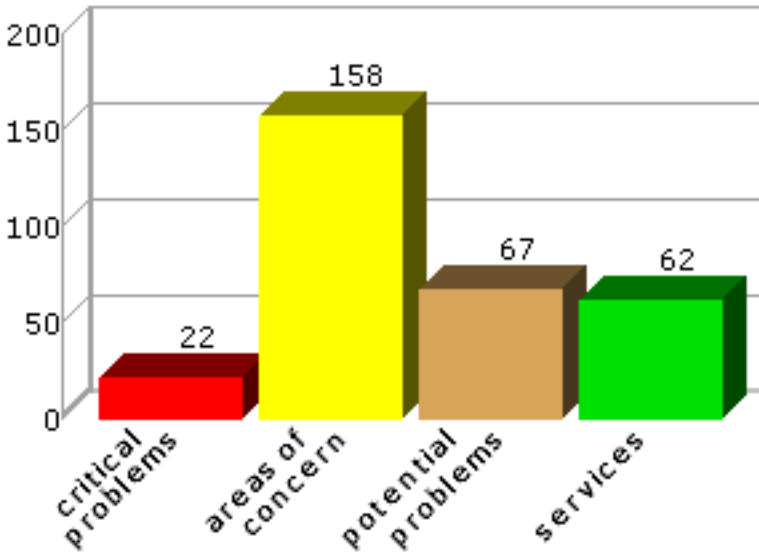
On December 14, 2015, at 11:23 AM, a FISMA assessment was conducted using the SAINT 8.9.28 vulnerability scanner. The scan discovered a total of three live hosts, and detected 22 critical problems, 158 areas of concern, and 67 potential problems. The hosts and problems detected are discussed in greater detail in the following sections.

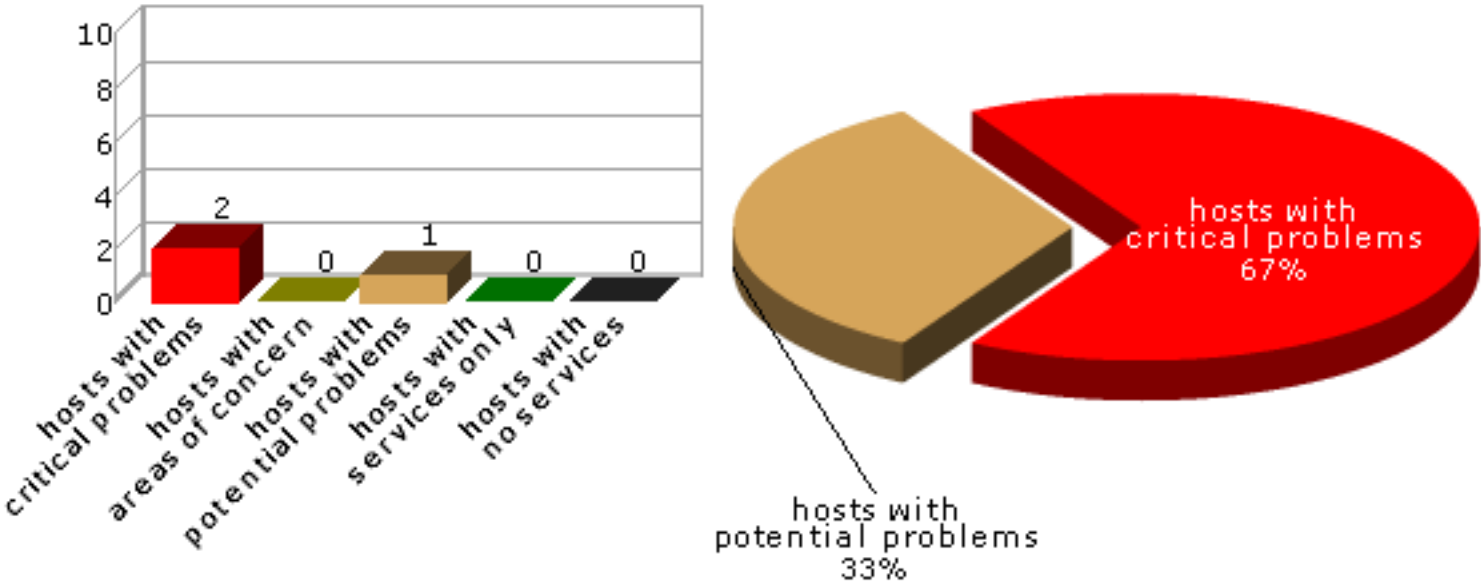
2.1 Vulnerabilities by Severity

This section shows the overall number of vulnerabilities and services detected at each severity level.



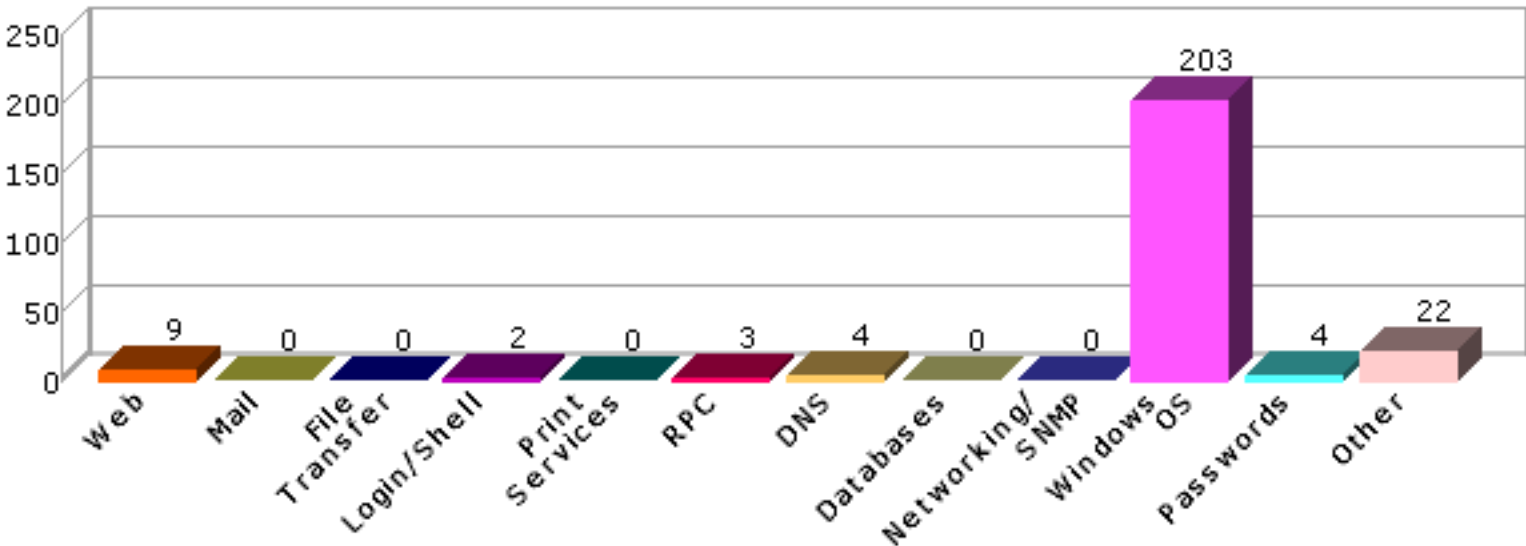
2.2 Hosts by Severity

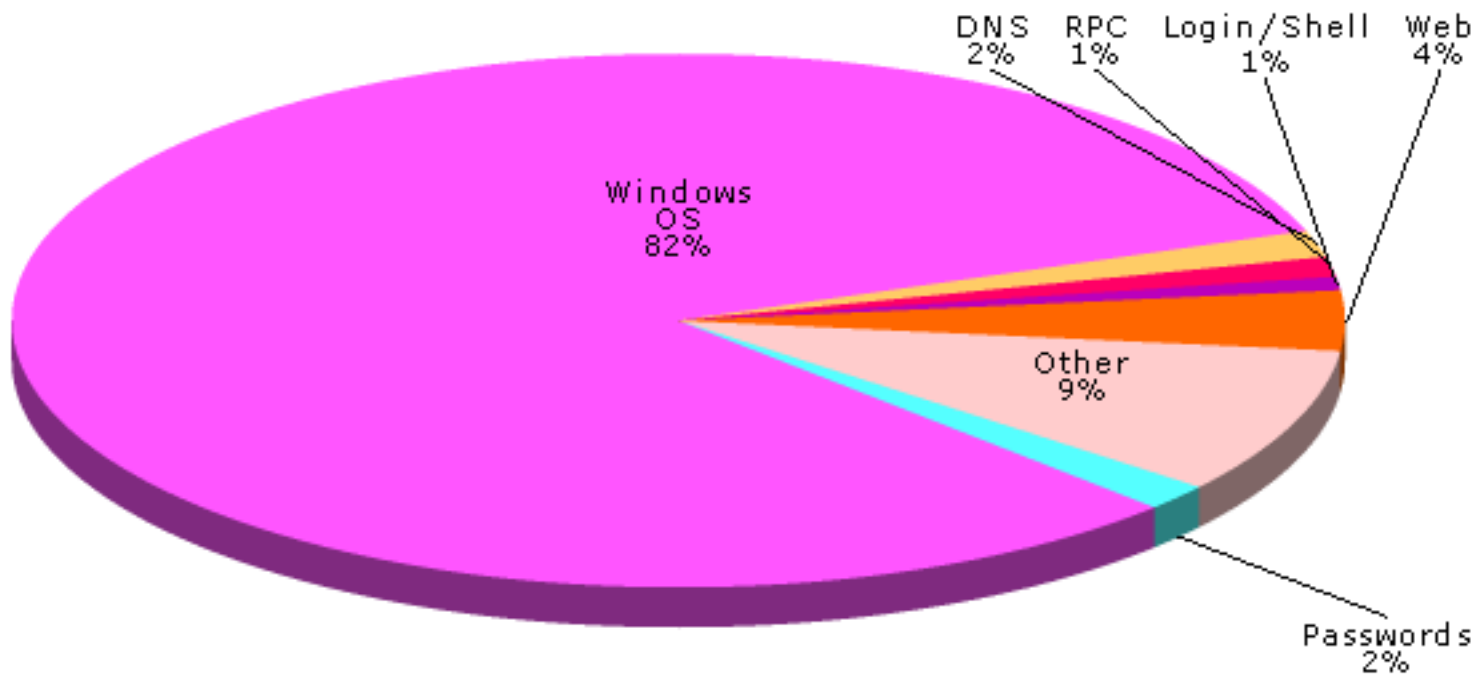
This section shows the overall number of hosts detected at each severity level. The severity level of a host is defined as the highest vulnerability severity level detected on that host.



2.3 Vulnerabilities by Class

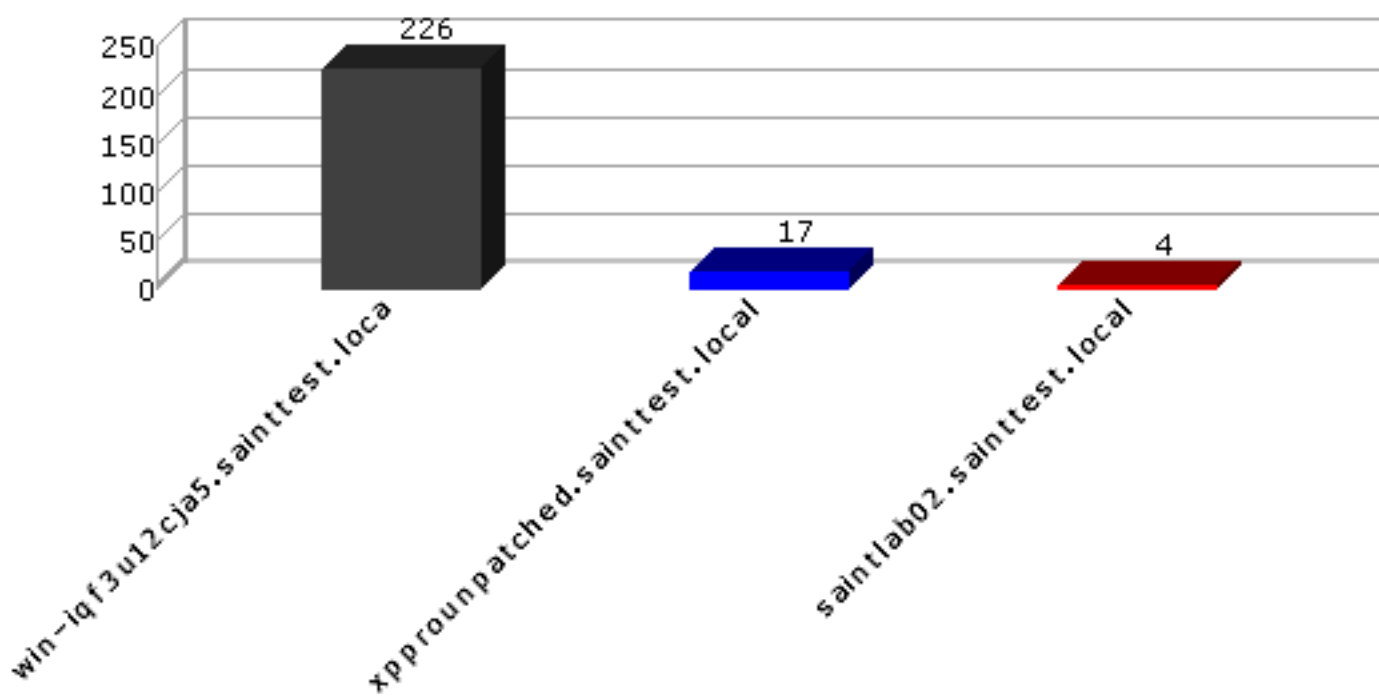
This section shows the number of vulnerabilities detected in each vulnerability class.





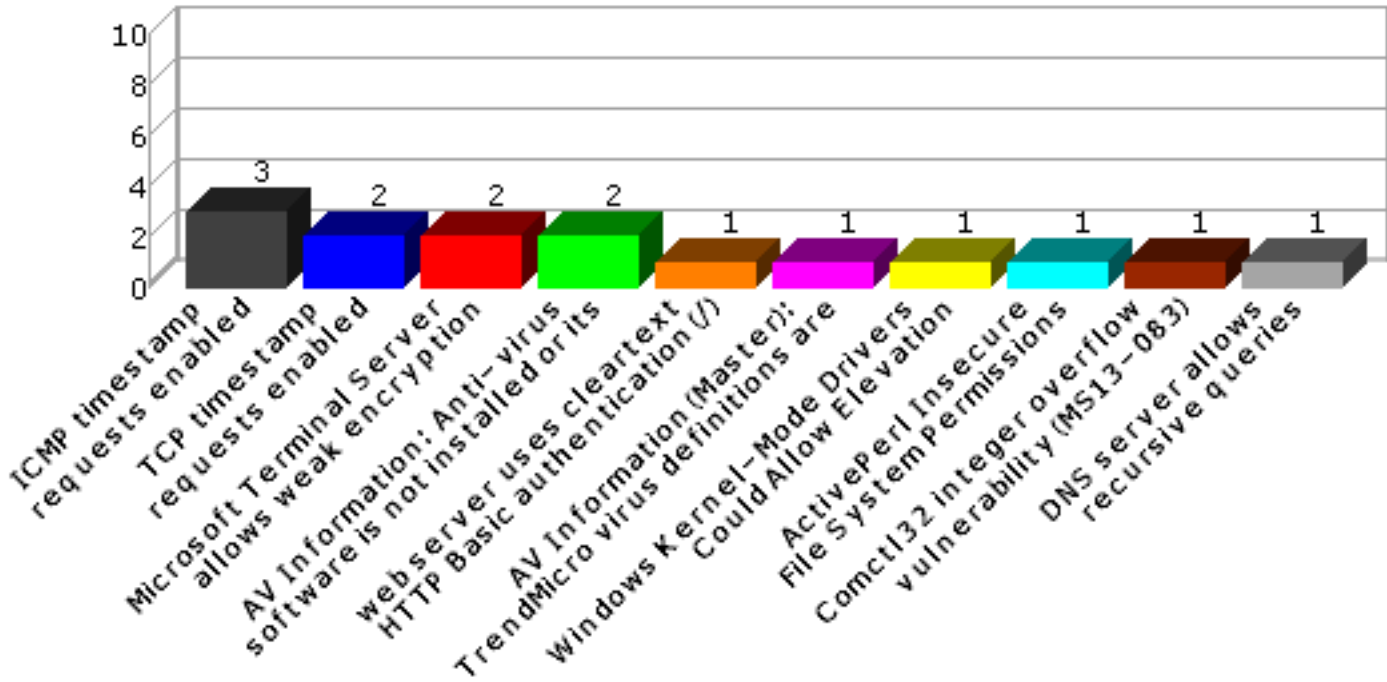
2.4 Top 10 Vulnerable Hosts
